2024 CAMP ALKULANA REGISTRATION

Registration is now open for Camp Alkulana for the summer! The Camp staff is happy to announce the dates for camp and welcome interested families to register. Space is limited, so please share this information as soon as possible with your congregations and youth activities.

Our summer camp program is the heart of our work; we believe a good camping program provides a ripe opportunity for life-changing experiences. Each summer we serve approximately 200 campers, ages 9-14, in a traditional overnight summer camp setting. Our four summer sessions are divided by age and gender. Our aim is to provide a camp experience for campers who would not otherwise be able to afford it. Therefore, the majority of our camper spots go to children and youth who are eligible for the USDA free or reduced lunch programs in their schools. Our campers are from the greater Richmond area, including Richmond city, Henrico, Hanover, Chesterfield, and Petersburg. Campers pay from \$40-\$200 for their camp experience.



RCFN WILL BE HOSTING A YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING ON MARCH 26, 2024

This is a public education program which introduces participants to the unique risk factors and warning signs of mental health problems in adolescents, builds understanding of the importance of early intervention, and teaches individuals how to help an adolescent (ages 12-18) in crisis or experiencing a mental health challenge.

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS LEARN? The course teaches participants the risk factors and warning signs of a variety of mental health challenges common among adolescents, including anxiety, depression, psychosis, eating disorders, AD/HD, disruptive behavior disorders, and substance use disorder.

WHO SHOULD TAKE THE COURSE?
